

Cultural Tour Itinerary with 2 Special Events.

Day 1 Arrival - Ulaanbaatar

Arrive in Ulaanbaatar. City tour in the afternoon with a visit to Natural History Museum to see the collection of dinosaur fossils and with a visit to Sukhbaatar Square.

Overnight at 4 Star Hotel. (L, D)

Day 2 Special Event “13th century National park” (130 km)

After breakfast visit Gandan Monastery. Little more than 1 hour drive we see 40m tall Chinggis Khaan's monument surrounded by many Mongol tribe camps. After short stop we'll continue driving to east. About 1 hour drive we'll reach back to 13th century.... Mongol kingdom. Lunch with Mongol Kings as merchant Marco Polo did in many century ago. Walk around many different camps included shaman's camp and handicraft camp. After all this drive back to modern time have a dinner and stay overnight at the ger camp. (BLD)

13 Century National Park comprises Chinggis Khan's giant statue museum and Live museum "Town from 13 century". The ancient nomadic mini kingdom is located in the distance of 130 km east of Ulaanbaatar in area of Erdene sum of Tov Province. It takes 2 hours driving on paved road.

Enormous statue of Chinggis Khaan mounted on horseback and holding horsewhip will be discovered on the way to 13th century National Park. In the live 13th century kingdom you will see and experience the authentic lifestyle of Mongols, who were lived in powerful Mongol Empire's period. This place gives you a same feeling that famous traveler Marco Polo and William Rubruck felt once upon time.

Day 3 Middle Gobi (300 km)

Our overland journey begins today. Drive to Middle Gobi with lunch at Chinggis Namarjaa Ger Camp at beautiful area of Zorgol Hairhan mountains. From here you will be able to appreciate the endless plains of Mongolia. Visit Baga Gazriin Chuluu Rock formations. Overnight at Ger Camp. (B, L, D)

Day 4 South Gobi - Flaming Cliffs (350 km)

Driving the country side with remote ger settlements, herders on horseback with cattle or camels arriving in the late afternoon at Bayanzag-Flaming Cliffs. Explore the Gobi Dinosaurs Cemetery and the trail of paleontologist Roy Chapman Andrews. Overnight at Bayanzag Ger Camp. (B, L, D)

Day 5 South Gobi - Vulture Valley (80 km)

Drive to Khan Bogd ger camp, situated on rocky slopes with panoramic views across the plains. Full day excursion to Yol Valley (Eagle Valley) National Park for hiking and an opportunity to photograph the stunning landscape of the Gobi Glacier and the local wildlife. Picnic lunch in the Yolyn Am National Park. Spend the afternoon hiking or

relaxing. Return to the camp and overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 6 South Gobi - Singing Sand Dunes (180 km)

After breakfast drive to Hongriin Els Singing Sand Dunes (170 km). After lunch hiking tour to the dunes. Visit camel breeding nomadic family in the Gobi and have a camel riding session. Dinner and overnight at Tuvshin 2 or Gobi Discovery Camp. (B, L, D)

Day 7 Ongiin Monastery (280 km)

Overland journey through famous Ongiin Steppe to the ruins of the Ongiin Monastery (190 km). Boxed lunch on the way. In the afternoon walk to the ruins of the Ongiin Monastery. Overnight Ongiin Hiid Camp. (B, L, D)

Day 8 Karakorum (260 km)

Drive to Karakorum. Stay at Anar Ger Camp with beautiful location at Orkhon River. In the afternoon visit Erdene Zuu Monastery. Also easy hiking along River to the nearby Mountains is possible. Overnight at Anar Camp. (B, L, D)

Day 9 Hustain Nuruu Protected Area (200 km)

Drive to Hustain Nuruu Protected Area to see the Prjewalski Wild Horses. Also visit Turkic graves and stone men, or hun chuluu, and the Ongot archaeological complex. Overnight at Ger Camp. (B, L, D)

Day 10 Mongol Naadam - Hotel Mongolia (20 km)

Drive to Hotel Mongolia in the Gachuurt Resort area. (180 km) In the afternoon attend Mongol Naadam festivities. Overnight at the unique hotel. (B, L, D)

The core of the Mongol Naadam is a small version of the famous National Naadam Festival, which is held on 11-13 July annually. It features the same three manly games as the National Naadam. The main purpose of the 'Mini' Naadam we hold, is to enable our guests to get closer to the amazing spectacle of wrestling, horseracing and archery. In this way they can capture the close-range photos or videos that will last forever as priceless memories of Mongolia.

Day 11 Ulaanbaatar

After breakfast heading back to Ulaanbaatar. Afternoon at leisure for shopping, visiting cozy cafes and beer garden. Farewell dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)

Day 12 Departure

After breakfast at hotel transfer to the airport for departure. (B)
